Description

The 1921 \$1 High Relief, also known as the 1921 Peace Dollar High Relief, is a prized possession among coin enthusiasts for its rarity and unique place in history.

The high relief caused challenges in the minting process, including creating uneven coin thickness and making them difficult to stack. To address these issues, the

design was modified for subsequent Peace Dollars, resulting in the high relief version becoming significantly scarcer.

- **Historical Significance:** The 1921 High Relief represents the very first Peace Dollar design. Following World War I, the US Mint aimed to create a new silver dollar design symbolizing peace. Italian immigrant sculptor Anthony de Francisci's design won the competition, featuring Lady Liberty on the obverse and an eagle clutching an olive branch on the reverse. However, the high relief aspect proved impractical, and the design was adjusted for later mintages. Therefore, the 1921 High Relief serves as a historical artifact of the initial concept for Peace Dollars.
- **Value Determination:** A 1921 Peace Dollar High Relief's value hinges on its condition.
