Description

The 1921 Morgan Silver Dollar, a remarkable piece from the series' final year, boasts an impressive mintage predominantly struck at the Philadelphia Mint, with over 44 million coins produced. However, this particular example stands out due to its Choice designation, where the intricate detailing on the eagle's feathers and the boldness of the strike are excellent representatives of the mint's craftsmanship during this period of heavy production. Created by George T. Morgan, this dollar is a testament to America's post-World War I economic resurgence, transitioning back to peacetime minting operations. Its luster and surface preservation elevate its desirability among collectors, providing an opportunity for completion in both date and type sets, while its commonality in high grades still intrigues those focused on maintaining premium-quality collections. Minted alongside the Peace Dollar, which heralded a new era, this Morgan Silver Dollar remains a symbol of transition, standing as an accessible yet historically rich collectible in numismatic circles.
