LOT 26 - 1921-S Morgan Silver Dollar Graded MS 62 by NGC



Description

The 1921-S Morgan Silver Dollar, encapsulated by NGC with an MS 62 grade, represents the final year of a renowned series and holds a distinct position due to a mintage of 21,695,000 coins. While abundant compared to other dates, its San Francisco mint origin adds a layer of intrigue, as S-mint Morgans are often noted for their strong strike and appealing luster. Designed by George T. Morgan, this coin showcases his iconic Liberty head, reintroduced in 1921 after the halt of production in 1904. Collectors will appreciate the solid strike typical of this issue, even at the lower mint state levels, with minimal contact marks for its MS 62 grade. As Morgan dollars are a centerpiece for many collections, adding a 1921-S offers historical completion and enhances a set, especially given the nuance between the different mint facilities in this pivotal year.
