Description

The 1921 Morgan Silver Dollar, struck in the final year of this iconic series, boasts substantial historical significance as it marked the return of silver dollar production after a 17-year hiatus. Representing a robust mintage with over 44 million minted at the Philadelphia facility, this common date within the series is valued for its role in concluding the Morgan lineage. Renowned for its intricate depiction of the American eagle by George T. Morgan, this piece exhibits the type's characteristic shimmering luster and a well-defined strike typical of Philadelphia's state-of-the-art techniques at the time. Collectors are drawn to this quintessential American coin, both as an accessible entry for completing a Morgan Dollar set and for its symbolic bridge to the subsequent Peace Dollar. Notably, this coin's condition and eye appeal can add significant numismatic value beyond its bullion content, making it a desirable piece among connoisseurs.
