**Description**

The 1882 Morgan Silver Dollar, bearing the Philadelphia Mint's characteristic absence of a mintmark, boasts a significant mintage of 11,100,000 pieces, but it remains a desirable acquisition for type set collectors due to the quality of its striking and available grades. This particular example is graded MS 61 by NGC, highlighting its respectable mint state condition amidst the series' offerings. The intricacies of the Morgan design, conceived by George T. Morgan, are evident in this specimen, showcasing a good level of detail and a modest cartwheel luster typical of Philadelphia's relatively superior strike quality. As collectors seek to complete series with coins that exemplify the harmonious balance between historical significance and technical merit, the 1882 Morgan is a strong candidate due to its accessibility and impeccable representation of late 19th-century American numismatic artistry. With an existing demand driven by registry set assemblers, this piece could fulfill a crucial role in both competitive settings and comprehensive collections.
