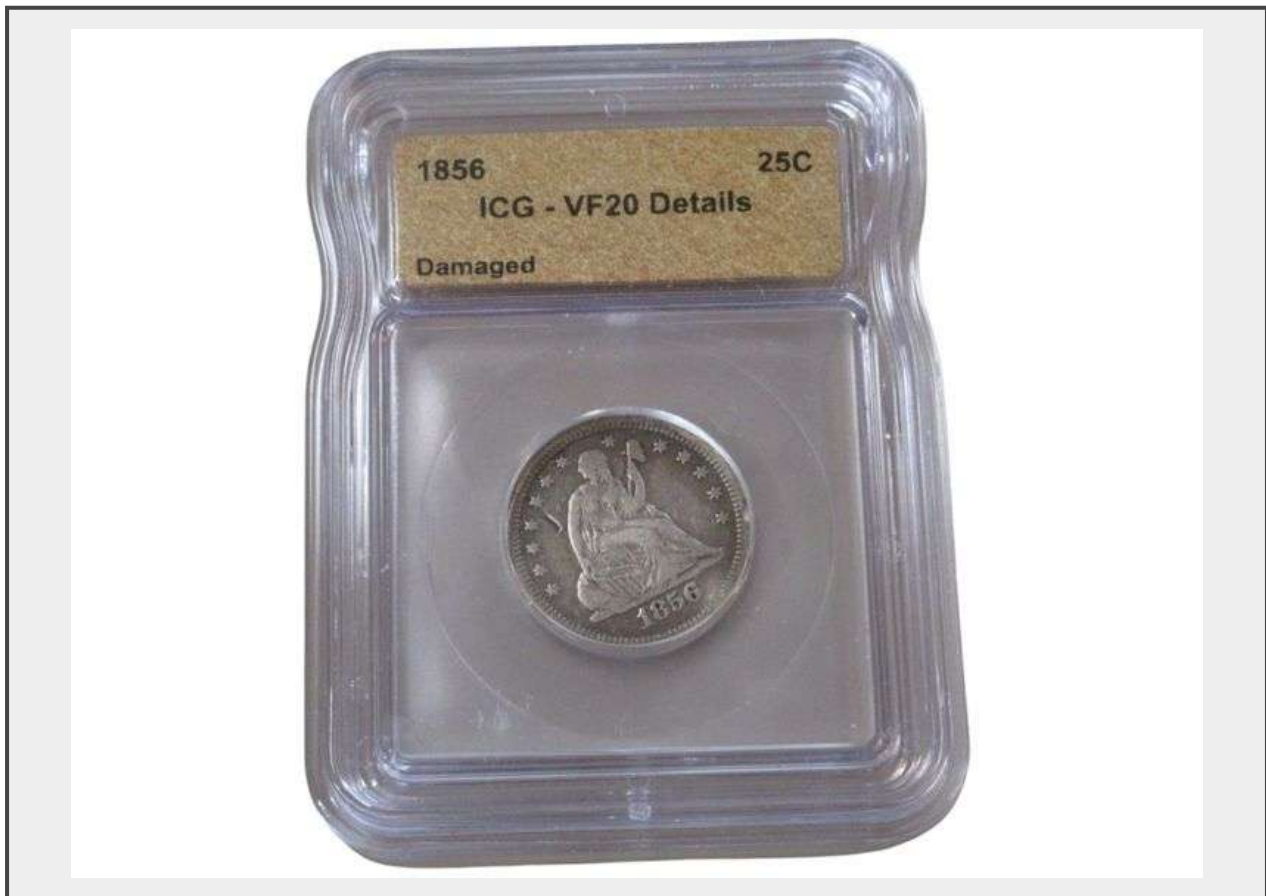

LOT 13 - 1856 Seated Liberty Quarter ICG VF20 Details Damaged



Description

The 1856 Seated Liberty Quarter, minted at the Philadelphia Mint, is a notable piece within the Seated Liberty series, which features designs by the renowned engraver Christian Gobrecht. With a mintage of 1,000,000 coins, this date is relatively common, yet it remains a significant collectible due to its historical context during the mid-19th century, a period marked by economic fluctuations and the looming Civil War. This particular example, graded ICG VF20 with details noted for damage, offers an opportunity for collectors to acquire a piece of American numismatic history, albeit with some surface imperfections that may affect its overall appeal. Despite the damage, the coin retains its characteristic design elements, including the iconic Liberty seated with a shield, which reflects the era's artistic sensibilities. The Seated Liberty series is known for its multiple design variations, and this quarter serves as a representative type coin for those looking to complete their collections. While the market for damaged coins typically commands lower prices, this piece still holds value for collectors focused on type sets or those interested in the historical narrative of U.S. coinage.
