LOT 5 - 1857-O Seated Liberty Quarter PCGS G06



Description

The 1857-O Seated Liberty Quarter, with a mintage of just 2,500 coins, is a notable semi-key date within the series, making it a highly sought-after piece for collectors. Struck at the New Orleans Mint, this coin reflects the design by engraver Christian Gobrecht, which features the iconic seated Liberty figure, a representation of freedom and strength during a tumultuous period in American history marked by economic challenges and the lead-up to the Civil War. Graded PCGS G06, this example exhibits the characteristic wear expected at this grade, yet retains enough detail to appreciate the artistry of its design. The survival rate for this date is quite low, with only a handful of examples known to exist in higher grades, enhancing its desirability among advanced collectors. As a key date in the Seated Liberty series, this quarter not only serves as a significant historical artifact but also as a cornerstone for any serious numismatic collection focused on 19th-century American coinage.
